

## Direct Ancestors of Dr. Pierre Laborde I

(Cathy Lemoine Sturgell – November 2023)

### First Generation

1. **Dr. Pierre LABORDE I** was baptized on 5 Apr 1746 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>1-3</sup> He was a Surgeon at Pointe Coupée and was later a Surgeon at Avoyelles Post. He also served as coroner for the area. He died by 27 Sep 1816.<sup>4</sup> Pierre had his estate in succession by 27 Sep 1816 in (Avoyelles Parish), Louisiana, United States.<sup>5</sup> According to Randy Decuir's "The Mansura French", court records support that Pierre Laborde was a man with a violent temper.<sup>6</sup>

### Second Generation

2. **Jean Baptiste LABORDE II** was born about 1710 in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France. He was listed as 27 years of age on his 1737 marriage record. According to his age at the time of his burial, however, he was born about 1708. He died on 17 Apr 1769.<sup>7-9</sup> He was buried on 18 Apr 1769 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>10-11</sup> His burial record identified his occupation as *Notaire et procureur au Seneschal de Tartas* (Seneschal was identified in medieval times as a steward or principal administrator in a royal or noble household; office later declined in importance to the equivalent as a bailiff). Catherine Alexis LAMÜE (LEMAE) and Jean Baptiste LABORDE II were married on 19 Mar 1737 in

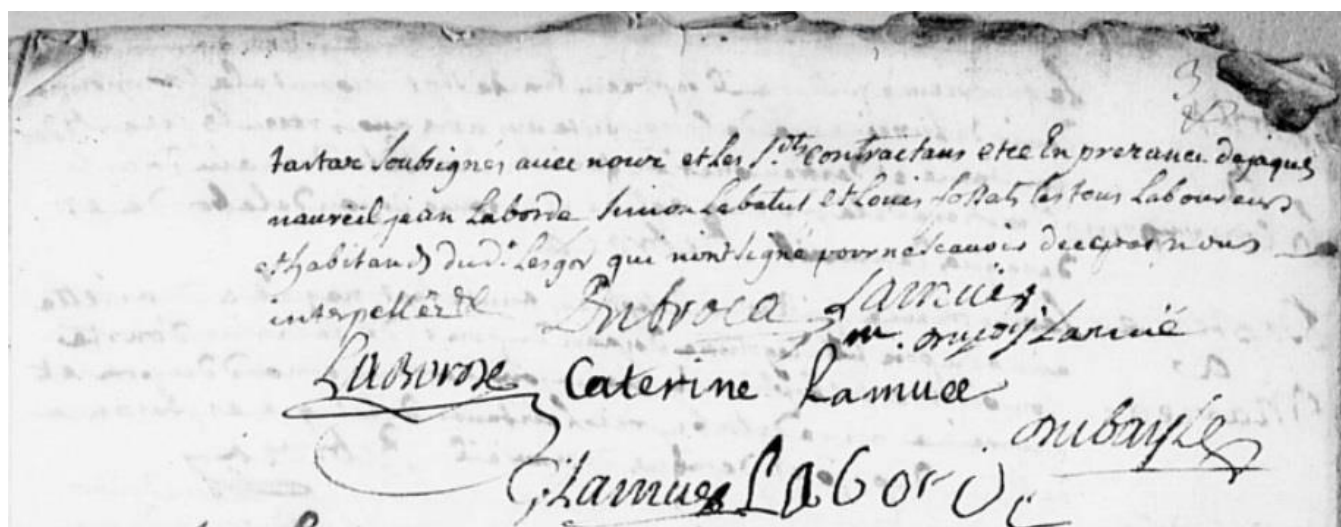
Lesgor (Landes) (Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>12-13</sup> In their marriage record, Jean was identified as 27 years of age and Catherine was identified as 23 years of age. Although both of Catherine's parents are listed in the record, only the father of Jean Baptiste is listed, and this somewhat confirms the death of his mother prior to 1737. Also, one of the witnesses to the marriage is Louis Fossats who was likely a relative of the woman who is believed to be Jean Baptiste Laborde's mother, Marie De Fossats.

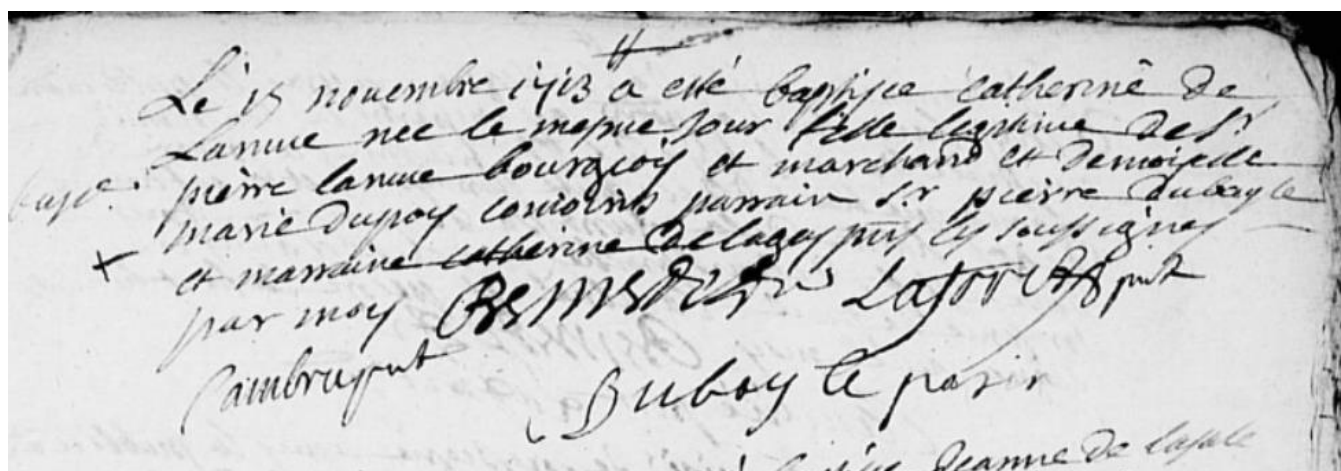

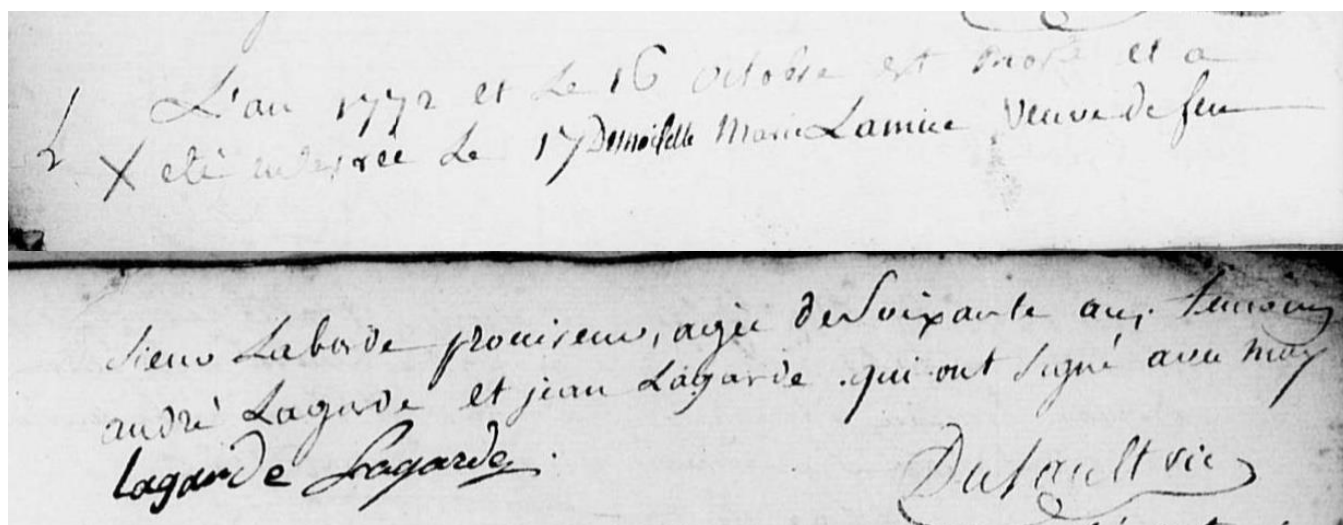
Jean Baptiste Laborde and Catherine LaMüe – 1737 Marriage Record

3. **Catherine Alexis LAMÜE** was born and baptized on 15 Nov 1713 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>14</sup> She died on 16 Oct 1772.<sup>16</sup> Catherine was buried on 17 Oct 1772 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>17</sup> Note that she is listed as Marie LaMüe on her burial record, widow of deceased Sieur Laborde.



Catherine LaMüe – 1713 Baptismal Record

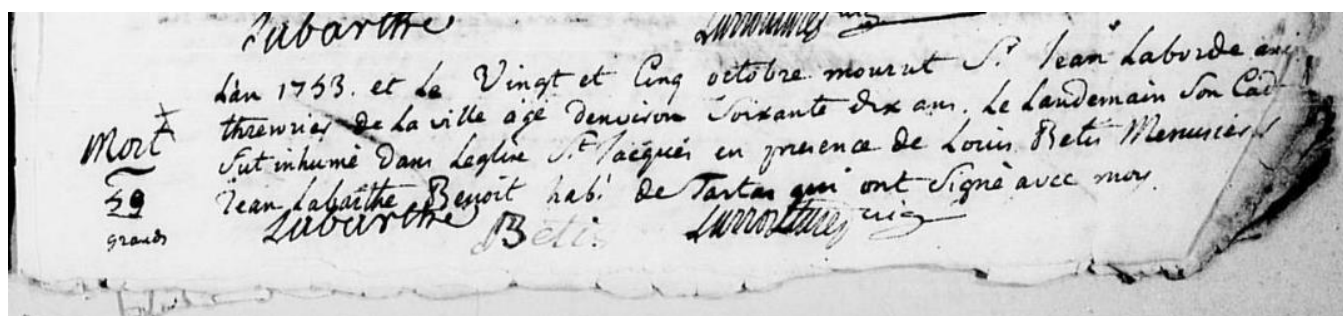




Catherine LaMüe – 1772 Burial Record

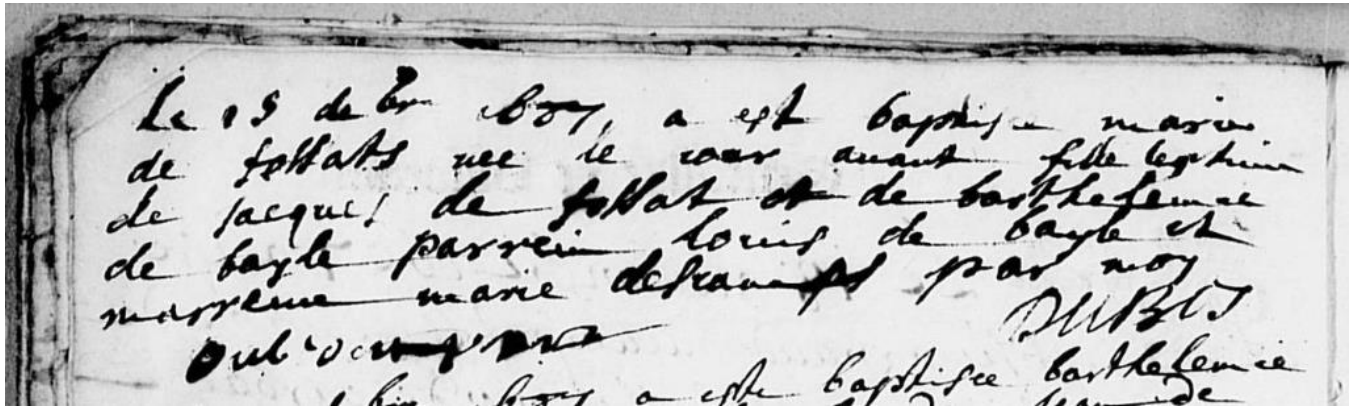
## Third Generation

4. **Jean LABORDE I** was born about 1683. The year of birth is determined by the fact that he was approximately 70 years of age at the time of his death in 1753. He died on 25 Oct 1753.<sup>18-19</sup> He was buried on 26 Oct 1753 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>20-21</sup> Jean was a Maître cordonnier / Trésorier de Tartas (Master shoemaker / Treasurer of Tartas).

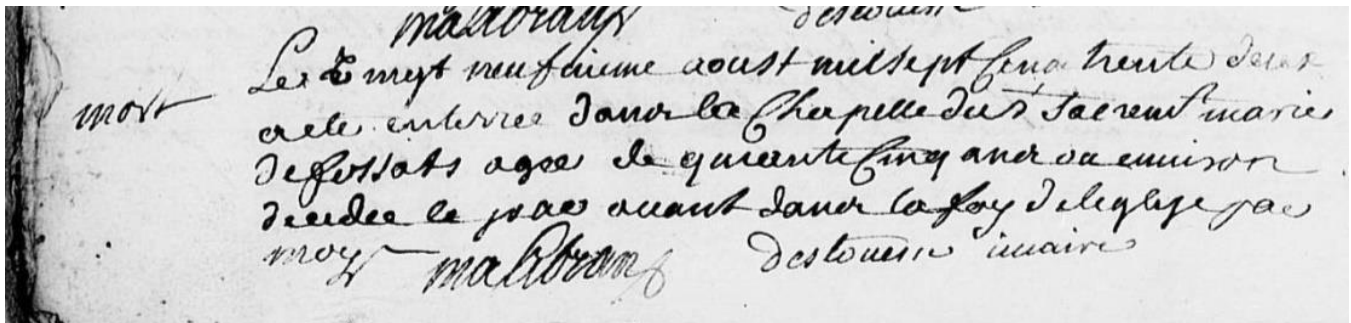


Jean Laborde – 1753 Burial Record

5. **Marie DE FOSSATS (FOSSATO)** was born on 14 Dec 1687.<sup>22-23</sup> She was possibly baptized on 15 Dec 1687 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France, although it cannot be proved positively that this is her baptismal record because her marriage record (listing her parents) has not been found. However, it is strongly suspected that this is her baptismal record; it corresponds to the estimated year of birth based on the age at her time of death.<sup>24-25</sup> She died on 28 Aug 1732.<sup>26-27</sup> Marie was buried on 29 Aug 1732 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>28-29</sup>

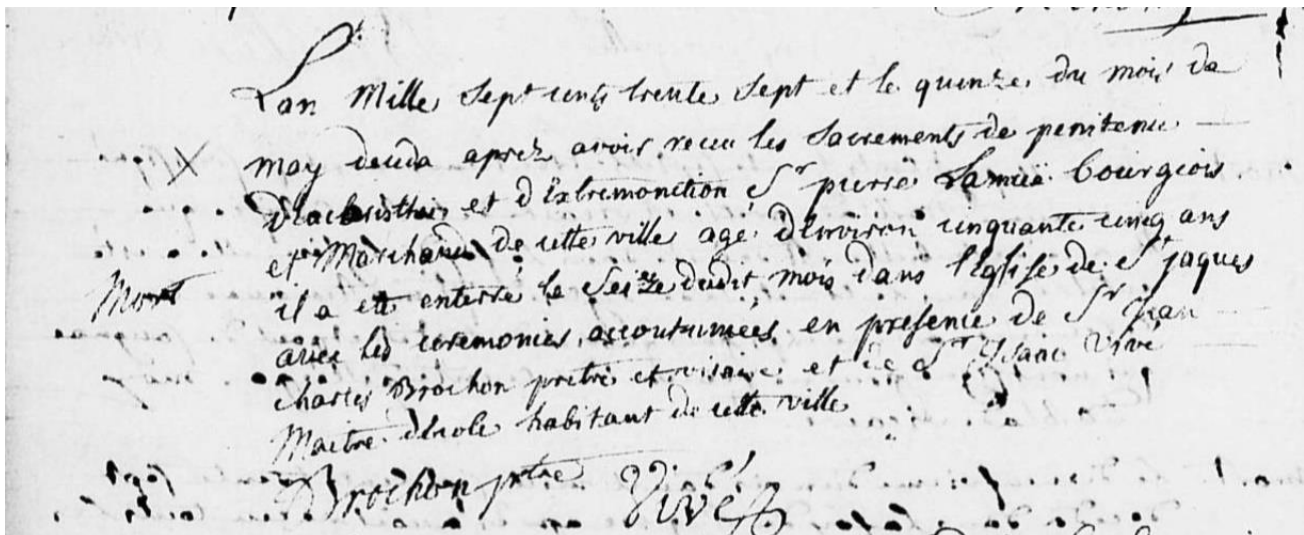


Marie De Fossats – 1687 Baptismal Record

6. **Pierre LAMÜE** died on 15 May 1737.<sup>30–31</sup> He was buried on 16 May 1737 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>32–33</sup> He was a Bourgeois and Marchand (Merchant) at Tartas in 1737. Marie DUPOUY (DUPOY) and Pierre LAMÜE were married on 9 Nov 1706 in Saint-Vincent-de-Paul (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>34–35</sup>

7. **Marie DUPOUY (DUPOY)** was born about 1685. She died on 31 Dec 1753.<sup>36–37</sup> She was buried on 1 Jan 1754 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>38–39</sup>

## Fourth Generation

10. **Jacques DE FOSSATS (FOSSATO)** was born about 1658. He died on 7 Oct 1688 at the age of 30 years (per his burial record).<sup>40</sup> He was buried on 8 Oct 1688. Although the burial was recorded at Tartas, the record states that he was buried at the Église de Saint-Anthoine. I was unable to identify any such town or church in or near Tartas. However, there is a church named Église Notre-Dame-et-Saint-Antoine in Mano (Landes), France, although it is over 40+ miles away and cannot be confirmed as the correct place of Jacques burial. It is possible that the church no longer exists and, therefore, can't be identified.<sup>41-42</sup> Barthélema (Barthéléme) DE BAYLE and Jacques DE FOSSATS (FOSSATO) were married on 5 Feb 1685 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>43-44</sup> Jacques was identified as a tissierand (weaver) on his marriage record and was listed as 24 years of age (which would put his birth clear closer to 1661); Barthélema was stated to be 22 years of age. Although the parents of Jacques De Fossats have not been identified, they were both alive at the time of his 1685 marriage, and the mother of Barthélema was alive (her father is not mentioned).

11. **Barthélema (Barthéléme) DE BAYLE** was baptized on 2 Apr 1662 at Église Saint-Jacques in Tartas (Landes) (Nouvelle Aquitaine Region), France.<sup>45-46</sup>

12. **Pierre LAMÜE** was born (date unknown).

13. **Jeanne Marie DE SALIGNES** was born (date unknown).

14. **Jacques DUPOUY (DUPOY)** was a Jurat perpétuel de Tartas (possibly a perpetual sworn municipal magistrate).

15. **Marguerite DE FOSSATS** was born (date unknown).



## Fifth Generation

22. **Jean DE BAYLE** was likely deceased by 5 Feb 1685. He was not mentioned in his daughter's 1685 marriage record.

23. **Margueritte DE SOUBIOL (SOUBIELLE)** died after 5 Feb 1685 – the date of her daughter's wedding in which she was mentioned.
